Award and Selection Criteria

The Manmeet Sharma Perpetual Professional Driver Award

This award is available to recognise drivers in the industry who have been a credit to their profession through their safe driving and the general standards demonstrated through the loyalty they have shown the company employing them. (The same criteria will apply to a person in charge of a transport company who drives their own vehicles).

The person nominated for this award must be a professional bus driver currently working as a local or long distance driver. He or she must demonstrate the following:

1. A minimum of 7 years continuous experience as a professional bus driver,
2. A good driving record with a demonstrated focus on safety (all speeding notices, traffic infringements and previous accidents must be declared).
Nominees driving history to be submitted with the nomination,
3. A high degree of pride in their personal and vehicle presentation,
4. A high degree of skill in customer service relevant to their role,
5. A professional attitude towards their job, their customers and the industry as a whole,
6. A strong interest in furthering the professional image of the industry, as demonstrated by their actions.
7. Up to a maximum of 3 nominations per organisation.
